My artwork for the Omnia Art Prize, "After the Rain" features an attributive frame with 3D "Gates and Fences" motif I custom made (3mm relief). I consider it part of the work (in the Pre-Raphaelite tradition), lending meaning to the painting being symbolic of lines crossed and ways barred, but through which there may be openings

"After the Rain" refers to memories of the nightly tropical thunderstorms in Bogor, West Java, and the mirrored scene of the scene to the periods in my life that came before, and after, we lived there; a shocking change of circumstances when our father took his life. There was definitely a before and after. West Java is an incredibly beautiful place and 12-year-old me found the Brisbane suburbs of the 80's a very far remove, and some core part of me was gone. But enough of the tropics remained so that every time it rained, I felt connected to something that I'd lost but I couldn't catch it in my hand, it was quicksilver.
